General Directions to Loyola University Chicago

Loyola (111 East Pearson) is located 1.5 miles north of both the DePaul downtown campus and the Club Quarters Hotel next to the historic *Water Tower* (Chicago fire), at the north end of Michigan Ave. (*Magnificent Mile*). Transportation between DePaul and Loyola (Jackson Street and Chicago Ave. stops) by subway (**Red Line**), bus, or taxi is short, inexpensive and pretty much door-to-door service.

General Directions to DePaul

DePaul is located in the Loop District of Chicago at 1 East Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois. The University is easily accessible by plane, train or automobile.

These stops are within a couple of blocks of the Club Quarters hotel at 111 West Adams Street.
